REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be pursuing a degree in the fine arts, either performing or visual.
- Applicant must reside within the Oconomowoc Area School District boundaries, **OR** be a student at Oconomowoc High School.
- Please bring no less than four and no more than six pieces of artwork to share with the judges. All two dimensional work must be mounted (does not have to be framed). Please include at least one example of something you have made outside of a classroom assignment.
- Music students, please bring an additional copy of your music for the judges.
- Statement of Purpose
You are required to include a Statement of Purpose of no fewer than 300 and no more than 750 words. Your statement should be typed on a separate sheet of paper and should address the following questions:
 - A. Why did you select the work you submitted for your scholarship judging experience?
 - B. How do you hope people will react when they look at or listen to your work?
 - C. What role does art/music play in your life?

Applications will be judged on content and appearance.

Please submit five collated packets, each containing the following in order:

- The completed application form
- Grade transcripts
- Three letters of recommendation, two in your field (Limit length to 1 page each)
- Statement of Purpose
- Include only one self-addressed stamped letter-size envelope

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED IF ALL FIVE COLLATED PACKETS AND A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE ARE NOT INCLUDED

After the approval of the application, the applicant will be requested to appear for a closed interview with the scholarship judging panel. This will be held at the **Oconomowoc Arts Center on Saturday, May 1, 2010, 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.** At that time, you will be asked to display examples of your work (easels will be provided). Applicants performing music will provide their own accompaniment (piano will be provided). Students MUST attend the interview. Interview will run approximately 10 minutes in length. The Arts Scholarships will be presented at the Oconomowoc Festival of the Arts at Fowler Park in Oconomowoc on August 20 and 21. The Festival of the Arts Board establishes the amount of the scholarships and the number to be awarded each year. **A recipient is limited to two awards.**
